VI. SPILL OR LEAK PROCEDURES

STEPS TO BE TAKEN IN CASE MATERIAL IS RELEASED OR SPILLED:

Small: Mop up with absorbent material and transfer to hood.

Large: Isolate from oxidizers, heat & open flame. Stop spill at source.

Pump liquid to salvage tank. Remainder may be taken up on absorbent
material & shoveled into container.

WASTE DISPOSAL METHOD: Allow volatile portion to evaporate. Contaminated
absorbent may be deposited in a landfill in accordance with local, state &
federal regulations.
